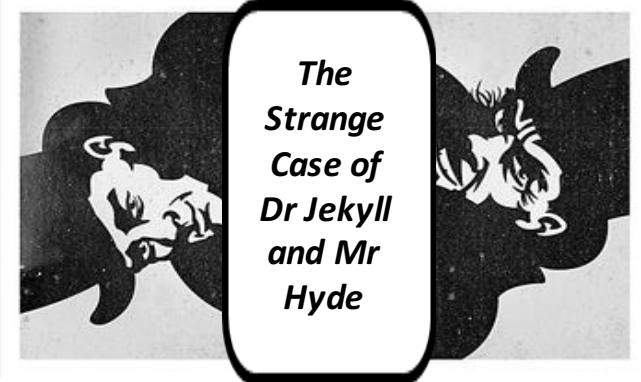
“Mr. Utterson the lawyer was [...]cold, scanty and
