





#### 15<sup>th</sup> January

Closing date for all other courses

## Applying to University

- Apply Online
- Choose 5 course
- Reference
- Write a Personal Statement



## What should it look like?

It is a formal application

4,000 characters / 47 lines

Paragraphs are important

Spelling, grammar and punctuation should be perfect



## Your personal statement

#### What is it?

A chance for you to explain why you are a good applicant, and why a university should accept you.

### Why is it important?

Most courses and universities don't interview, and make an offer based on your personal statement and grades.



### Personal Statement

#### Content:

-Commitment, interest and enthusiasm!

Analytical and reflective, not merely descriptive

 Relevant (and transferable) skills and abilities


-Work experience

- Understanding of the course applied for

-Rough rule of thumb

- 75% academic (3000 characters/35 lines)

- 25% personal (1000 characters/12 lines)




4 main things to include

The course

Skills and achievements

Hobbies and interests

Career aspirations and progression



## The Application Process

Once a University receives your application, they may:

- -Invite for interview / audition
- Conditional Offer
- Unconditional Offer
- -Reject

## The Application Process

Once you have received replies from all of your choices, you can:

- -Accept as first choice
- -Accept as insurance choice
- -Reject

UCAS Extra available

#### End of June

Late applications process closes
