10.3	Section B: The Changing Economic World Global economy and Nigeria	Students start off looking at development around the world - how it's measured and why it's different and then they focus on a specific region for ways in which the development gap can be reduced and more specifically how tourism can be used to reduce the gap Continuing on from the previous work students will be looking at a major case study of a country that has undergone rapid economic development and then they will contrast this with economic development in the UK today and in the future
