We have a policy of no mobile phones

- Students are not allowed to use mobile phones in school
- We want to make sure students are concentrating on their learning with no distractions
- If students' mobile phones are used, seen or heard in school the phone will be confiscated, with the SIM card
- Only Parents and carers will be able to collect confiscated phones from reception on the following Friday from 3.10pm
- That also means if the phone is confiscated on Friday it can only be collected the following Friday
- Phones will not be given back to the student, only directly to the parent/carer

There may be occasions after attending an extra class or after school event when students wish to use their phone. They either need explicit permission from a member of staff who is with them or they need to leave school premises to do so.

If a student's phone goes missing staff will not search for it

- If students wish to call home they can do so at reception.
- If you need to contact your child, please call reception and a duty officer will deliver the message.
- You can however report directly to the Police on telephone number '101' and you will be asked to give the phones IMEI number.

Sixth formers

- These rules also apply to sixth formers.
- The only exception is that sixth formers are allowed to use their phones in their new common room at break or lunchtime only.
