# UPDATE ON AUTISM

Next term we will be delivering whole school CPD to all staff focused on understanding ADHD and using Pupil Passports and one tool to know our ADHD community, and their strengths and support needs better.

Ahead of Autism Acceptance Week (2-8th April this year), we have Matthew from the Hackney Neighbourhoods Team coming to speak with some of our Y9 and Y10 students about his experience from an autistic strengths based perspective.



We'd like to share this resource with families - we have found it really helpful as a team. The Nest Approach aims to support autistic young people with meltdowns and was written by autistic adults, in equal partnership with autistic young people from the gaming community in response to autistic young people sharing the negative impacts of support that has been offered while they are experiencing meltdowns.
