

Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form PE non-participation policy

- All students are expected to bring their PE kit to every lesson, even if they are not physically participating.
- If a student is unable to take part physically, they will still be expected to contribute to the lesson i.e. umpiring or coaching.
- The level of participation will be determined by the PE teacher, based on the student's condition and teacher's judgement.
- A parent note explaining the reason for non-participation may be accepted for a short-term issue. However, the final decision on participation remains at the teacher's professional judgement.
- If a student is too unwell to engage in any way, it may indicate they are too unwell to be in school.
- For ongoing or more serious medical conditions, a doctor's note or medical evidence may be required to excuse a student from PE over an extended period.
